

Lansing Home and Garden Show FAQ's

- **What is the Spring Show?**
 - It is the MSU Horticulture Club's big event for the year. It is first a giant plant sale and we also landscape the conservatory to a theme; Alice in Flowerland
- **Why do we have the Spring Show?**
 - It is the MSU Horticulture Club's fundraiser so that we can go to industry events like trade shows and competitions. We also provide scholarships for our members and fun activities to do together (bonfire and camping trip). It also provides students with a unique opportunity to run a small business in what they are studying. One very special thing about our show is that all of the plant material that we sell is donated to us, so it shows that people in the industry know how important this show is to teaching possibly future employees and to spread the love of horticulture through the club.
- **What is the MSU Horticulture Club?**
 - It is one of the oldest clubs at Michigan State and we bring horticulture students together to provide them with networking opportunities and to get to know the students in their classes better. The club is also open to non-majors who have an enthusiasm for what we do.

 - The show is held in the headhouse and the conservatory in the Plant and Soil Science Building on the corner of Wilson and Bouge.
